

Additional Considerations for Dog Parks



1. Have two areas: one for smaller dogs and one for larger dogs. List area distinctions on the Park Rules.
2. Be sure to post a sign indicating which area is for smaller dogs and which area is for smaller dogs.
3. Make the small dog area for dogs that are 30 pounds or less.
4. Require park registration so that all dogs and owners in the parks are known.
5. Do not allow dogs and owners outside of the community to use the dog park.
6. Prohibit spike, pinch, and prong collars while inside the park.
7. Install a shaded area and seating for dogs and humans to rest and cool off.
8. Install a human and dog accessible water fountain.
9. Install a bag dispenser and waste receptacle.
